About University

RKDF University, Bhopal was established in the year 2012 by an act of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and Recognized under section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956. RKDF University Bhopal is one of the fastest growing university of central India offering a wide range of undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programs in Engineering and Technology, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Management, Computer Science, Education, Health sciences, Science, Social Science, Commerce, Humanities and Languages, Architecture,Homoeopathy, Nursing, Agriculture and Law.

RKDF University strives to ensure that students' education is multidimensional and we have adhered to a multidisciplinary approach. It has an excellent ambience and distinctly hospitable environment for higher learning in various subjects. The University facilitates interaction with national and foreign institutions to broaden the knowledge and skill of students. Flexibility in choice of courses, periodical revisions of courses, interdisciplinary and integrated courses as per the national and global requirement are the emerging issues that University envisaged to introduce in future. Sound grasp of fundamentals, good analytical skills, awareness of contemporary problems, reasoning abilities and exposure to the rapidly changing technologies are an integral part of the teaching in the campus.

Ph.D. Programme

Applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. programmes against vacant seats available in various disciplines under approved supervisors of the University. The duration of the programme shall be a minimum of three years {One semester (6 months) course work followed by 2.5 years of research}.

The programmes are offered under regular mode in strict compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022. Admitted scholars will be governed by Ordinance of RKDF University Bhopal and amendments thereof.

The selection of candidate will be made on merit prepared from marks obtained in the entrance test (weightage 70%) and marks obtained in Personal Interview (Weightage 30%).

Candidates, who have qualified UGC/CSIR/DST INSPIRE/National/State Level Fellowship GATE/GPAT/SLET/NET shall be exempted from Ph. D. entrance test 2023 and shall eligible for appearing in personal interview. However, submission of application form shall be mandatory for all aspirants irrespective of qualification and/or fellowship.

The candidates who have been awarded teachers fellowship by statutory bodies for doing Ph.D. degree shall also be exempted from entrance test and shall be eligible for admission based on marks obtained in personal interview.

Eligibility

Applicants who fulfills following criteria shall be treated as eligible for appearing in entrance examination:

(1) Candidates who have completed: i. A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

(2) Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

(3) Candidates who are in final year of Qualifying Degree can also apply. However, such candidates have to submit their provisional certificate on or before the last day of admission.

How to Apply

- 1. Application forms are available on our website <u>www.rkdf.ac.in</u>. The applicant should fill the form as per given instructions.
- 2. Candidate should enclose documents in proof of their educational qualifications and others along with the application form.
- 3. Requisite fees of Rs. One thousand only (Rs. 1000/-) may be paid either through demand draft/NEFT/Challan (Only available in University Campus). The DD/fees payment receipt should be enclosed along with completely filled application form.

- 4. Candidate should write his/her name, e-mail id/mobile number on the back side of the fee transaction receipt.
- 5. The filled form along with self-attested copies of all mark sheets and demand draft/transaction receipt may be sent by post or submitted in person to the office of Exam Controller, RKDF University, Airport Bypass Road, Gandhi Nagar, Bhopal (M.P.) 462033.
- 6. The soft copy of filled forms may also be submitted through e-mail on rkdfuniversityexam@gmail.com
- 7. Necessary documents to be mailed along with the filled application form are:
 - (a) Scanned copy of documents towards proof of educational qualifications
 - (b) Proof of National State Level Qualifications/Fellowship
 - (c) Others as may be applicable
 - (d) Scanned copy of demand draft/fees transaction receipt.
- 8. Last date for submitting the form (hard copy/soft copy) is **06.10.2023**.

However, the applicants who prefer to send their application forms through email shall be required to submit hard copies of their application form in original on or before 06.10.2023 along with proof of entrance examination fees paid up to the last date of acceptance of application form.

Important: Applicants who have submitted their forms through e-mail needs to submit original copy of the form along with other enclosures and proof of entrance examination fees paid in the office of Exam Controller on or before 06/10/2023, failing which they shall not be allowed to appear in the entrance examination.

Details of Entrance Examination Fees

The Entrance examination fee for the Ph.D. Programme 2023 is Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One thousand only). The applicant may transfer requisite amount through online transfer or draw a Demand draft of the amount on any nationalized bank payable to RKDF University, Examination Bhopal or deposit the required amount through bank challan at Punjab National Bank, University Branch (Gondermhow, Bhopal).

Fee payments made after last date (06/10/2023) shall not be considered for appearing in the entrance examination.

Written test: Scheme

The Entrance test Paper will consist of two parts: Part - I and Part - II

Part- I:

Part – I shall consist of 40 multiple Choice Questions of General Awareness, Research Aptitude, Reasoning and Research Methodology. Questions shall be of 01 mark each.

Part - II:

Part- II shall consist of 60 multiple Choice Questions framed from within the Syllabus of concern subject uploaded/ provided at University website. Questions shall be of 01 mark each.

Scoring

- (i) All objective type questions (four options with single correct answer) would carry one mark for each correct answer.
- (ii) More than one answer indicated against a question will be deemed as incorrect response.
- (iii) There will be no negative marking in objective type question paper. Qualifying the entrance exam does not confirm the final selection, after qualifying the entrance exam the candidate will have to appear for

personal interview.

Admission counseling

Following candidates shall be eligible for appearing in personal interview (PI):

- (a) The entrance examination qualified students
- (b) The Candidates who have qualified UGC/CSIR/DST INSPIRE/National/State

Level Fellowship/GATE/GPAT/SLET/NET shall be allowed directly in the PI. The candidates shall be required to discuss their research interests at the time of PI. Candidates are advised to bring proof of achievements/ projects/ dissertations/ publications in support of their candidature.

Entrance examination admit card

- 1. Entrance examinations admit card will be provided on the e-mail as provided by applicant.
- Entrance examinations admit card will not be sent to the candidates by Post. Candidates have to download and get a printout of Entrance examination admit card from their respective mail.
- 3. Candidates must carry Entrance examination admit card and one additional photo identity proof such as a Driving license/college/university identity card/Pan card/Aadhar card, etc. to the Entrance test center.
- 4. Candidates without admit card and photo identity proof shall not be allowed to appear for the entrance examination.

- 7. If any declaration made by the candidate is found for admission is found to be false at any stage, his/her admission shall be cancelled and he/she will be liable for prosecution under the law.
- 8. If a candidate, who is not eligible to appear in the Test, does so, he/she will not have any claim whatsoever for admission.
- 9. The University shall have right to deny admission in any discipline, if suitable candidate is not found.
- 10. The decision of the University shall be final.
